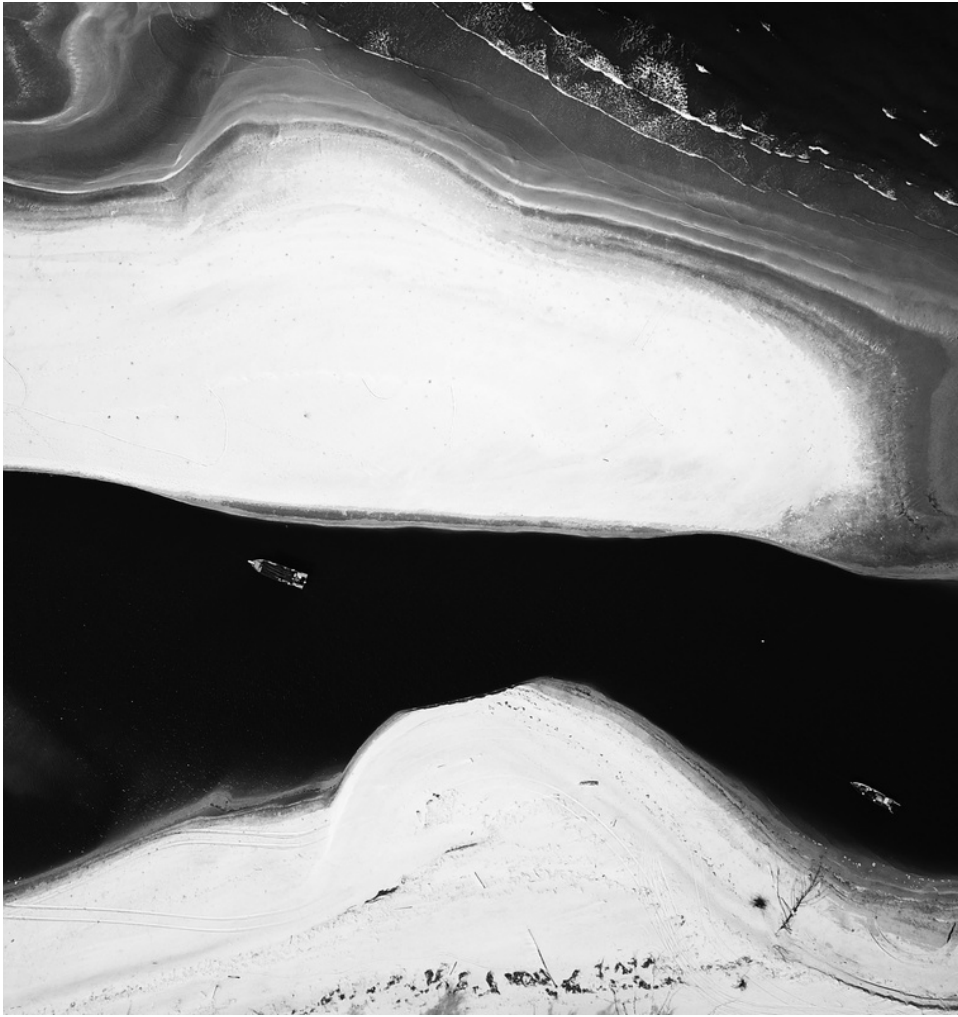


TRACK 1

03 LEADERS RAISED

“We have different gifts, according to the grace given us.” ROMANS 12:6 (NIV) “All of you together are Christ’s body, and each of you is a part of it.” 1 COR 12:27 “[I pray]... that you may know the hope to which He has called you.” EPH 1:17-18

04 CHURCHED RELEASED

People Saved

We consider reaching people who do not know Jesus personally to be one of our greatest responsibilities. Our Sunday services are for people at all stages of their spiritual journey.

Our Sunday services focus on **four values**:

1. We believe church should be **enjoyable.**

"I was glad when they said to me, 'Let us go into the house of the Lord.'"

Psalms 122:1 (NKJV)

2. We believe the church should be a place where people experience **God's presence.**

"But...when some unbelievers or ordinary people come in, they will be convinced of their sin by what they hear. They will be judged by all they hear, their secret thoughts will be brought into the open, and they will bow down and worship God, confessing, 'Truly God is here among you!'"

1 Corinthians 14:24–25 (GNT)

3. We believe the church should be a place where people learn how the **Bible applies to their daily lives.**

"So Christ Himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors, and teachers, to equip His people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up."Ephesians 4:11–12 (NIV)

4. We believe the church should be a place where people can accept **Jesus as their Lord and Savior.**

"'Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.' But how can they call on Him to save them unless they believe in Him? And how can they believe in Him if they have never heard about Him? And how can they hear about Him unless someone tells them?"

Romans 10:13–14 (NLT)





Talking about Jesus

One of our primary purposes is to reach people far from God. Every one of us can do our part by living out these four principles:

Accept personal **RESPONSIBILITY**.

Build a personal **RELATIONSHIP**.

Share your **STORY**.

Give a personal **INVITATION**.

How we Participate

1. PRAY

Pray that we might reach people in each of these areas with the Good News of Jesus.

“Then He said to His disciples, ‘The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into His harvest field.’” [Matthew 9:37–38 \(NIV\)](#)

2. GIVE

Give your time and resources to reach people for Jesus.

“Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will also be.” [Matthew 6:19–21 \(NIV\)](#)

3. GO

Go to our cities, nation, and world to serve others and show people the love of God.

“Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, ‘Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?’ And I said, ‘Here am I. Send me!’ He said, ‘Go and tell this people...’” [Isaiah 6:8–9 \(NIV\)](#)



Disciples Made

Connect Groups

Leaders Raised

Life Track exists to help you discover and develop your purpose and live the full life God created for you. Life Track is made up of four parts, which guide you through the next steps in your journey to see people saved, disciples made, leaders raised, and the church released.

The Church Released

All of us were created by God to make a difference in the world around us. We believe God made every single person with the desire to make a difference, and the way we do that is through the local church. God has a place for you where your unique abilities and passions can impact the lives of others. We believe your life will never make sense until you find, develop, and fulfill your purpose.

Giving

“Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this,” says the Lord Almighty, “and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it.”

MALACHI 3:10 (NIV)

At Life Center, we practice tithing and the giving of offerings. We recognize that giving 10% of our income is the Biblical standard for giving. To understand what it means to be a follower of Jesus, we must also understand what it means to be a giver.

1. Tithe

The tithe, or “first fruits” of our labor/income belong to God. We find this principle all through God’s Word. Tithing, giving God the first 10% of our income to the local church, is the primary, practical way we acknowledge that God is first (Proverbs 3:9–10).

2. Offerings

An offering is giving over and above the tithe. The Bible says that by giving generously, we are able to “take hold of the life that is truly life.” You aren’t really living unless you are freely giving (1 Timothy 6:18–19).

The Church Released

Many people love to give to God and as they do, they want to feel confident in the organization through which they give. At Life Center, we want people to understand they are giving to God through the church, not to the church. As we openly share the honesty, integrity, and spiritual values that guide the financial practices of Life Center, we believe people can focus on what God is calling them to give and trust that He is leading our church to steward it well.

The giving of tithes and offerings is worship to Jesus and an expression of the relationship between the individual giver and the Lord. That is why we don't have people fill out pledge cards or make faith promises. Funds are not "income only," they are worship and are not considered to be a business transaction but an expression of gratitude toward God.
